Russia Exchange Trip

Our hearts go out to the 13 families who were affected by the cancelation of the exchange trip to Russia this spring. We know this has been extremely disappointing, frustrating, and a loss financially. We have been informed that the ASD legal department is working on getting some measure of a refund for those who did not travel. MIR Parents also contributed \$9000 towards the trip cost; it remains to be seen if a portion will be refunded.

Three Russian immersion middle school students and their parents, who were previously committed chaperons for the group trip, did indeed continue on the trip, without authorization from the ASD. Their issued visas allowed for their travel since each of the three students were accompanied by a parent(s). Thankfully, they made it to Russia and back safely.


